ong ago glaciers carved out the Wisconsin countryside. A century ago the Ringling and Golmar brothers shaped a part of American history from this same region. Today the same rolling hills hold the culmination of one horsewoman's dream, Domino Stables, a complete Morgan equestrian facility.

Domino Stables started not far from the "Greatest Show on Earth's" winter quarters. Owner Susie Weiss purchased a small parcel of land while still in high school. She spent a couple of years working at East Coast stables before returning to Wisconsin to build a small barn and begin training horses.

Susie's interest in Morgans and a breeding program began out of necessity. She was asked to develop and lead an equestrian program at a local youth camp. Susie's quest for dependable, athletic horses brought her to local Morgan breeders. She purchased some mares, and then began raising Morgans for use

in the program. In 1980, Cosmos Morgans was born with the purchase of Saddleback Sentinel. This now 22-year-old stallion possesses the right bloodlines and characteristics to develop exceptional Morgan offspring. Cosmos, her farm prefix, means unity and harmony, and Saddleback Sentinel's offspring epitomizes those attributes. Susie regrettably passed on the youth equestrian program as Domino Stables grew. The demands of her stable's program required more and more of her time.

Cosmos Morgans are willing to perform at just about every endeavor. Whether in dressage, on the trail, in a performance class, or out for a Sunday afternoon drive, Cosmos Morgans became synonymous with family enjoyment.

Cosmos Morgans found a niche with the resurgence of carriage driving. Success has smiled on Susie and her Morgans. Cosmos Rokytok, Cosmos Brittany, and Cosmos Razel Dazel have been successful at almost every driving event in the Midwest. Cosmos Special Time and Cosmos Tiger Lily won the 1988 World High-Point Pair Driving Championship and the AMHA Open Competition Pair Driving Championship. Cosmos Rokytok was the 1991 Grand National Heritage Salute to America Single Champion. Last year, Rokytok and Crisman's Misty Moon won the AMHA Open Competition Pair Driving Championship their first year together as a pair.

In the midst of their 21st year, Domino Stables has materialized into a full breeding, training, and showing facility. Susie and her husband, Gary Allen, enjoy introducing visitors to the world of Cosmos Morgans. Domino Stables is located five miles off Interstate 90-94.
